## USDA's Budget

- Total USDA Budget for FY 2010 was \$133 billion
- But...\$105 billion of this is for mandatory programs such as the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- And...of the remaining \$28 billion, just over \$16 billion goes to non-mandatory nutrition assistance, conservation and forestry programs, and farm and commodity support programs.

## USDA's Budget

- So, from the total USDA budget of \$133 billion, we are left with \$12 billion to cover everything else:
- Rural development
- Food safety
- Animal and plant inspection
- Marketing and regulation, etc., etc., and...
- Extension, Education, and Research

#### But where are we now????

- FY 2011: Continuing Resolution through April 8, 2011. That's 3 days from now.
- We have already lost \$134 million...
- Integrated 406 programs
- RFAs in general...impact on Office of Grants and Financial Management

#### Shut Down

- Travelers
- Mid-stream payments
- Computer systems
  - NIFA
  - IRS

#### FY 2012

- Although we do have a budget proposal for 2012, it is a very unusual one.
- Typically, the President's budget request starts with the previous year's level as a baseline.
- But you see the problem...we didn't know the baseline when we put the 2012 proposal together, and we don't know it now.
