# FY 2015 Recap

# FY 2015 Recap

- NIFA saw wins in FY 2015, receiving \$786,874,000 in funding for research and education activities and \$471.7 million for extension activities.
- In total, our funding level increased by \$11.846 million compared to FY 2014.
- Overall, funding for our priorities increased by \$8.591 million.



# FY 2016 Budget Request

- President Obama released his FY 2016 budget request with a top-line increase of \$213 million for NIFA.
- The President proposed \$20 million for new competitive capacity programs. Under this proposal, a portion of Evans-Allen, Hatch Act, Smith-Lever, and 1890's Extension for Research programs would be made available for competitively awarded grants.
