## ASRED Report to SAAESD, April 2021

- 1. New Extension Directors/Deans in the Southern Region
  - a. Dr. Tom Obreza is Interim Dean and Director, University of Florida
  - b. Dr. Ashley Stokes is Dean and Director, University of Tennessee
  - c. Dr. Mike Phillips is Director of the Alabama Cooperative Extension System
- 2. ASRED Directors are interested in recommendations for a Regional Leadership Development program and have formed a task force to make recommendations at our August meeting.
- 3. We also have a regional task force studying the impacts of educational strategy changes made by Extension as a result of COVID 19. Most state Extension Services recorded exponential increases in contacts via social media. Many were customers were new to Extension.
- 4. The Extension Health Initiative, led by the Health Innovation Task Force, announced a two-phased Immunization Initiative, with a focus on COVID 19, but not limited to COVID.
  - a. Immunization Campaign base amount of funding for every LGU (~\$24K for 1862s and ~\$26K for 1890s and 1994s)
  - b. Innovative Immunization Education Projects (~20, up to \$200K)
- 5. Due to the need to make contractual decisions early, the ASRED/AEA/PLN meeting in August will be a virtual meeting.
- 6. ASRED Directors and AEA Administrators are continuing and extending their *Coming Together for Racial Understanding* program.
- Directors recently reviewed an idea that may be useful as part of the next Farm Bill. See <u>Community Learning through Data Driven Discovery</u> (CLD3).
- 8. The ECOP Program Committee and the Budget and Legislative Committee are working together on six concept papers that can be used in advocacy and program development. They are:
  - a. Workforce Development and Recovery
  - b. Urban Agriculture and Extension
  - c. Broadband Infrastructure
  - d. Climate Extension
  - e. Health Extension
  - f. 4-H Positive Youth Development
